

## Website Re-Design Pro Bono Services

The National Law Center on Homelessness & Poverty (NLCHP) seeks pro bono website re-design services. NLCHP is located in downtown Washington, DC and serves as the legal arm of the national movement to end and prevent homelessness. NLCHP would like to engage a professional volunteer web design firm to make important, targeted upgrades in a cost-effective manner.

The NLCHP website ([www.nlchp.org](http://www.nlchp.org)) is a critical vehicle for NLCHP's communication with partner organizations and constituents, serving to provide breaking news and critical tools in the fight to end and prevent homelessness. There is currently a need for an upgrade to optimize its potential, further increase its navigability, and allow for more efficient maintenance.

Functions that NLCHP would like to add include: the ability to revise the front page more often and to embed videos on the home page, an interactive events calendar, a better content management system, the ability to add tabs to the top or sidebar of the main page, an improved ability for members or visitors to manage e-mail subscriptions, a better system for classifying NLCHP publications, an interactive forum for action alerts, and better analytical reports. These upgrades would allow NLCHP to keep local advocates informed about NLCHP trainings and other forthcoming events. With these upgrades, NLCHP's extensive library of publications, policy models, and advocacy tools could be made more user-friendly, allowing users to access more quickly the information they need. Each of NLCHP's program areas—housing, domestic violence, income, children and youth, civil rights, and human rights—could have the proper space to present critical information to the community groups that need it most.

### Qualifications:

The ideal candidate will demonstrate experience designing professional, user-friendly, interactive websites. Applicants should possess strong communication skills and be able to work with NLCHP staff on re-design. Successful candidates will be able to dedicate enough volunteer time to launch revised website by late summer 2009.
